Foundation 4Life® Legacy Center Bogota, Colombia

This family development center will provide a home for neglected, abandoned, and abused children. The center will provide preschool programs for children, skills training in computers and robotics for teenagers, trauma counseling, and a safe recreational space. The Bogota center will provide a protective environment for children and youth, plus education, love, counseling, shelter, and food.

Leaders of the SOS Children's Villages Youth Empowerment program will determine the 40 most at-risk youth in the community and invite them to be part of the program. Selected youth will have

access to individualized development plans to become self-reliant citizens. Each child will have a structured curriculum to help them overcome challenges and regain strength and confidence. The children will be monitored closely to insure they stay on track and have an opportunity to be reunited with family.

There are more than 570 million children living in poverty around the world. Our focus is on building lives—one child, one family, and one community at a time. Foundation 4Life and 4Life family members are changing the lives of individuals. Legacy Centers increase our service momentum and raise our impact to new heights. Together, we can give hope to individuals and communities in need.
