Hurricane Maria Relief Efforts in Puerto Rico

Salt Lake City, Utah (October 11, 2017) In partnership with 4Life distributors, employees, and executives, Foundation 4Life® donated more than \$100,000 of supplies and fuel and over 30 pallets of food to 4Life family members in Puerto Rico who were devastated by Hurricane Maria.

Platinum International Diamonds Juan and Damaris Rosado asked for donations during a Facebook Live video. Florida distributors and community members, many who were also victims of recent hurricanes, rallied together and gathered supplies to send to Puerto Rico. Thanks to their generosity, over 20,000 pounds of supplies were sent to aid distributors and their families.
